
Phlebology







Measure axilla circumference **cG**This leaves 1 or 2 choices.

STEP 2 Measure mid lower circumference **cD**This leaves 2 or 3 choices.


STEP 3 Measure wrist circumference **cC**This leaves 1 or 2 choices.

If there are still 2 options left, we recommend choosing the larger size for ease of donning, overall comfort and ultimate compliance.

Either size selection will deliver the desired therapy.







Measuring Circumferences

- The patient's hand should be placed palm down and the fingers should be slightly apart.

 As the hand is sensitive to pressure, the measuring tape should not be pulled tightly.


 Circumferential measures should follow the contour of the palm.
- **STEP 2** Measure and record the circumference at A over the MCP heads (as per diagram).
- **STEP3** Measure and record the circumference at B distal to the thumb web (as per diagram).
- **STEP 4** Measure and record the circumference at C, the wrist distal to the styloid process (as per diagram).
- **STEP 5** Measure and record the circumference at (X), the base of the thumb.
- **STEP 6** If a glove with fingers is required, measure and record the circumference at (X) the base of each finger (as per diagram).

Compare the measurements you have obtained with the following table to determine the correct size. Where measurements vary greatly, a custom-made glove is necessary.

Measuring Circumferences

- The patient should be seated, arm on table with palm facing upwards and elbow flexed to approximately 40°.
- Measure and record the circumference at C, the wrist. NOTE: At the wrist and elbow, the tape should never be pulled tightly, however, slightly firmer pressure may be used over fleshy areas, i.e. D, F and G points).
- STEP 3 Measure and record the circumference at D, the mid -point of the lower arm.
- Measure and record the circumference at E, the elbow. (Ensure the arm is slightly bent at [40°] before taking this measurement.)
- **STEP 5** Measure and record the circumference F, the mid-point between the axilla and the elbow.
- STEP 6 Measure and record the circumference at G, (take the measurement approx 1 cm below axilla).

 Compare the measurements you have obtained with the following table to determine the correct size.

 Where measurements vary across all three sizes, or are smaller or larger than the tabled measurements, a custom-made sleeve will be required.

CCL 1: 15-20 mmHg

- Tired aching legs

CCL 2: 20-30 mmHg

- Tired aching legs
- Moderate to severe varicoses during pregnancy
- Post vein surgery/post sclerotherapy
- Moderate tendency of oedema
- Superficial thrombophlebitis
- Helps prevent recurrence of ulcerations

CCL 3: 30-40 mmHg


- Severe varicose veins
- Lymphatic oedema
- Post vein surgery/post sclerotherapy
- Venous ulcers
- Manages manifestations of Post Thrombotic Syndrome (PTS), Chronic Venous Insufficiency CVI/CVD
- Aids in prevention of thrombotic syndrome

JOBST® Medical LegWear should not be worn and is contraindicated for the following conditions:

- Ischemia (eg. Advanced arterial disease)*
- Uncontrolled congestive heart failure
- Untreated septic phlebitis
- Phlegmasia cerulea dolens

*As part of a comprehensive assessment, a Doppler Ultrasound is used in the vascular screening process to clarify the vascular aetiology. A hand-held Doppler will assist in determining the degree, if any, of arterial disease. Using the Doppler the Ankle/Brachial Index (ABPI) can be calculated.



Put the hand inside the stocking and grip the heel.



Push the overlapping part of the stocking over the heel.



Turn the stocking inside-out, whilst still holding onto the heel.



Fold over the stocking and pull without using force.



Pull the inside-out of the stocking over the front of the foot as far as the heel.



Make sure that the heel of the stocking is free of creases.



Gradually pull the stocking onto the calf, like a normal stocking.



Pull the stocking up to the knee, thigh or waist; let it slide over the thumbs.

Knee high socks or stockings should finish 2 finger width's below the knee crease at the back of the leg.





JOBST® Stocking Donner

Due to the nature of compression stockings, people may find putting them on to be initially a challenging task. The JOBST® Stocking Donner, which features a lightweight frame and foam grip handles, is designed to aid in the application of all JOBST® Medical LegWear.



Place your JOBST® compression stocking inside the semi-circle frame and pull the top of the stocking down over the semi-circle. The heel of the stocking must face the back of your JOBST® Stocking Donner.

Continue to slide the stocking down over the semi-circle until the heel protrudes from the frame. and is centred and even.



Preferably whilst seated, grasp the padded handles and gently pull the stocking donner upwards whilst moving your leg slightly outwards, until the stocking is above the calf.

Whilst using a support for balance, insert your foot into the stocking until your foot is completely on the floor.

Helpful Tip: Sit down and hold the heel pocket against the frame as you slide your toes into the stocking.



Push the JOBST® Stocking Donner backward and down to free the stocking.

Be sure the heel of the stocking is properly placed on the foot. Then adjust the length and smooth out any wrinkles by stroking with the palm of your hands.

The knee band in Knee High socks or stockings should stop two finger widths below the crease at the back of the knee.







- 1. Turn the garment inside out before washing
- 2. Before the main wash, thoroughly hand wash the silicone band using a delicate fabric detergent. Concentrate on removing any lotions, hair or foreign material from the silicone.







Latent: A sub clinical state where swelling is not evident despite impaired lymph transport. This stage may exist for months or years before oedema becomes evident.

Mild: This represents early onset of the condition where there is accumulation of tissue fluid that subsides with limb elevation. This oedema may be pitting at this stage. Moderate: Limb elevation alone rarely reduces swelling and pitting may manifest. There may or may not be pitting as tissue fibrosis is more evident. **Severe:** The tissue is hard (fibrotic) and pitting is absent. Skin changes such as thickening, hyperpigmentation, increased skin folds, fat deposits and warty overgrowths develop.

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INTRODUCTION

Purpose of this document

- Measuring a flat-knit garment can be quite challenging as there are many aspects that need to be considered during the process.
- Being your trusted partner in compression therapy, we would like to ease the process of measuring and give as much support as possible.
- The goal is to come close to a standardized measuring for JOBST® flat-knit garments, in order to create compression hosiery that will have the best possible fit straight from the beginning.

When using this document, please keep in mind

- This booklet is a guide to measuring for JOBST® made-to-measure flat-knit compression garments and must be used as a guide only.

 Please use alongside the JOBST® order forms or the JOBST® e-shop.
- **Note:** this Measuring Standard does not replace any formal training on treatment of lymphatic and venous diseases or lipedema.

How to use this document

- Our JOBST® Measuring Standards have been developed as an interactive PDF, which you can use on any digital device.
- Using this document in full-screen mode enables you to interactively click through the slides, following the links while clicking on the respective buttons.
- Clicking on the footer, you will always be able to go back to the table of contents or the tension matrix.

JOBST® MEASURING STANDARD

General information

- The limb should be decongested before measuring for a compression garment and edema reduced through multi-layer lymphedema bandaging or JOBST® FarrowWrap® compression system.
- The best time to measure a patient for a compression garment is in the morning, or after a therapy session.
- Measure hands, feet, fingers and toes accurately to the nearest millimetre.
- Photo documentation is helpful in difficult cases.
- Documentation of body measurements (no tension) and order measurements are important in order to track changes of the edema.
- Do not measure into skin folds but place the measuring tape over the top of the skin fold.

BEFORE YOU GET STARTED

JOBST® MEASURING CARD

The measuring card is a measurement aid developed exclusively for arm sleeves, gloves and toe caps. The card allows finger and toe lengths to be determined very easily and precisely. Moreover, the measurement aid is used for positioning measurement point G on the arm.

JOBST® MEASURING BOARD

A measuring board is recommended for accurately measuring the lower extremities. It is particularly convenient to take combined length and circumference measurements without marking the patient's skin.

JOBST® ORDER FORM OR JOBST® ESHOP

In order to note down the measurements and place the order, please have either an order form or the JOBST® eShop prepared.

JOBST® MEASURING TAPES

Measuring tapes of different widths are recommended for taking measurements, depending on which areas of the extremities are being measured:

- A 0.5 cm wide measuring tape or appropriate finger / toe tape is used to ensure measurements to the nearest millimetre in the hand and foot areas.
- A regular JOBST® measuring tape to measure the remaining circumference and length measurements (feet, legs, possibly abdomen, hand and arm).

JOBST® SKIN PENCIL

A skin pencil is recommended for marking the measurement points.

Our JOBST® skin pencils are particularly skin-compatible and are easy to remove from the skin due to their fat solubility.

JOBST® FOAM PAD

The foam pad is a measuring aid developed for measuring length K.

The pad allows accurate measurement to be taken for point K. It is placed in between the groin area.

JOBST® ELASTIC BELT

The elastic belt helps the patient find the best position for themselves and delivers a secured position for the measurement. It aids in the measurement of circumference and length at point H and T, especially for JOBST® Confidence panty (AT) garment.

JOBST® TAPE CLIPPER

The tape clipper is used on a measuring tape. This is needed for taking rise measurement for JOBST® Confidence panty (AT) garment.



TENSION MATRIX

In order to measure for an optimal fit of our flat-knit garments, circumferential measurements should be carried out under different levels of tension.

As shown here, the tension can range from O (lay on measurement) to +++ (maximum tension).

Measuring for JOBST® flat-knit garments involves tensions 0 to ++ pull.







This garment has been developed to be soft and comfortable to the skin while sleeping or relaxing, forgoing the usage of a top band. It is not constructed for a lot of movement, especially strong bending of the knees. As a consequence the garment might move from its original position. If needed, adjust before and after sleeping. Furthermore, some patients might experience a slight volume reduction during the night and find the garment loose in the morning.

MEASURING FOR JOBST® LOWER EXTREMITIES

General

Please keep in mind:

- Medial measurements are taken on the inside of the limb; lateral measurements on the outside.
- Proximal refers to points closer to the head; distal closer to the feet.



When the patient is in a supine position:

- Position patient carefully on the measuring board.
- The foot must be flat on the board.
- The heel must be as close to the board as possible.
- If a measuring board is not available, make sure that the position of the foot is flexed and that the measuring tape is kept in a straight line from heel to pubic bone.

MEASURING FOR JOBST® LOWER EXTREMITIES

Measuring the foot

- First, measure the foot lengths with the patient standing. Mark all length measuring points on the foot.
- · The toe can be open or closed.







- · Please note that a slant foot offers the best anatomical fit.
- Please keep in mind that you can also measure for a slant foot with closed toe.

Lengths of foot (A, Z)

- Open toe straight foot: First measure the medial length from the back of the heel, to just under the base of the big toe. Continue with the lateral length from the back of the heel to just under the base of the small toe. Take the measurement in between to define length A.
- Open toe slant foot: First measure the medial length from the back of the heel, to just under the base of the big toe. Continue with the lateral length from the back of the heel to just under the base of the small toe. Note both measurements down.
- Closed toe: Also measure the total foot length from the back of the heel to the end of the longest digit on the medial side.
- Please note that for JOBST® Relax, only medial length A is taken (IA-medial).






A Circumference

- This measurement is taken with the patient standing.
- Measure circumference A at the base of the toes at the widest part of the foot.



• If measuring is done in lying position, please apply 0 tension.





Y Circumference

- · Position the patient in a supine position.
- Y circumference is taken around the heel to the front crease, at maximal dorsal flexion.



 If there are deep skin folds or irregular contours, measure cY more towards proximal.






B Circumference and Length

- Circumference B is measured just above the malleoli, at the narrowest part of the ankle.
- Length B is measured where the B circumference is taken.
- For JOBST® Relax, if cB is below 20 cm, cB should be measured with 0 tension.



 If the limb definition is unclear, we recommend taking the measurement 10 cm from the heel.







B1 Circumference and Length

- Circumference B1 is measured at the insertion of the Achilles tendon into the calf muscle.
- Length B1 is measured where the B1 circumference is taken.



 If you cannot feel the Achilles tendon, measure B1 at the midway point of length D.






C Circumference and Length

- This is an anchor-point for an AD garment (knee-high).
- Circumference C is measured at the greatest calf circumference.
- Length C is measured where C circumference is taken.
- For CT (Capri Style) if one may wish, the end point of the garment may be measured a little lower than the actual point C. But, the circumference has to be measured at exact point C.



 When calf circumference is unclear, C is located in-between B1 and D.





D Circumference and Length

- Circumference D is measured two fingers below patella at pre-patellar bursa.
- Length D is measured where circumference D is taken.



 If the patella is hard to feel, measure two fingers below the knee crease on the medial side (length).




E Length

- E length is measured across the middle of the patella.
- The leg must be extended and flat against the measuring board, with the foot in the correct flexed position (90 degree towards the board) and the heel as close to the board as possible.




E Circumference

- Circumference E is measured over the middle of the patella.
- The leg must be flexed (30-45 degrees).
- This allows comfort and range of movement while wearing the garment.




E1 Circumference and E1 length for Bermuda

- Point E1 is required for Bermuda style.
- Circumference E1 measured at approx 5 cm above point E.
- Length E1 is measured where circumference E1 is taken.



F Circumference and Length


- · Circumference F is located mid-thigh.
- This is the anchor point which holds the garment in place for AG (thighhigh) and AT (tights).
- Length F is measured where circumference F is taken.
- For AG-HT one legged panty, point F
 of the shorter leg (non compression
 leg) should be measured with 0
 tension. Also, length F of non compression leg can differ from
 length F of compression leg.
- For JOBST® Relax, if needed, slightly more tension can be used.



MEASURING FOR JOBST® LOWER EXTREMITIES

G Circumference and Length

- Measure point G with the patient standing.
- Circumference G is measured at the widest part of the thigh.
- Length G is measured up to the gluteal fold.
- Length and circumference may be taken at different points depending on limb shape.
- For AG-HT one legged panty, point G of the shorter leg (non compression leg) should be measured with 0 tension.
- For JOBST® Relax, if needed, slightly more tension can be used.




K Length

- · Measure point K with the patient standing.
- Place the JOBST® foam pad in between the groin area.
- Now measure the length K from floor to the upper edge of the foam pad in a straight line.

- Length K is not necessary for JOBST® Elvarex and JOBST® Elvarex Soft AG garment, unless you want to order a top comfort zone for JOBST® Elvarex.





• H circumference is measured over the widest part of the buttocks area.



H Circumference and Length for JOBST® Confidence

- You need to use an elastic belt to define and secure point H. Then, use a measuring tape and measure the circumference at the upper edge of the belt.
- Length H is measured at the side of the leg, from the feet up to the upper edge of the belt. Measure along the contour of the hip at the upper part.





TT (L) and K3 (L1) need to be measured in one go using the JOBST tape clipper and the elastic belt

Measuring length TT (L):


- Place the elastic belt comfortably around the waist.

- Gently extend the tape between the legs, through the crotch to the middle of the belt at the back side of the body. This is length TT (L).

Measuring length K3 (L1):

CG1 Armsleeve

This garment has been developed to be soft and comfortable to the skin while sleeping or relaxing, forgoing the usage of a top band. It is not constructed for a lot of movement, especially strong bending of the knees. As a consequence the garment might move from its original position. If needed, adjust before and after sleeping. Furthermore, some patients might experience a slight volume reduction during the night and find the garment loose in the morning.

WASH AND CARE INFORMATION

Please remind the user to keep in mind the following:



Washing the garments every day, or every other day, is important for hygiene and to maintain the elasticity and performance of the garment.



There are a few things to keep in mind when washing the garments:

- Wash the garments together with garments of the same colour.
- A laundry net can protect the garments from damage.
- · Wash the garments at the temperature indicated in the Instructions For Use, please refer to the washing label.
- Choose a gentle wash cycle.
- Do not use a brightener or fabric softener.



How to dry garments after washing:

Garments should not be dried in the sunlight as this harms the fabric.



What else should be kept in mind?

- Long fingernails and jewellery can damage the fabric when putting garments on or off.
- Do not use body lotions or greasy skin care ointments when wearing the garments.
- When any loose threads or loops are noticed, they shall not be cut off this can cause holes or ladders in the garments. Instead, the medical supply store shall be contacted to get a professional repair, when possible.



In addition, always advise to follow the Instructions For Use for the respective garments because they can differ from product to product.


Measure length IK

- Place the JOBST foam pad as far as comfortably possible into the crotch, between the legs.
- Measure perpendicularly from the floor to the top edge of the foam pad.



Measure length IT

- Place the belt at the desired waist place (approx belly button)
- Length T should be measured perpendicularly from the floor to point G. And then, following the contour from G to T.
- In other words, measuring tape should be placed in a straight line from floor to the hips and shall follow the contours from hip to the upper edge of the belt.



Measure length IH

- Put the belt around the widest part of the buttocks
- Measure perpendicularly from the bottom to the top edge of the belt



Measure length TT/K3

- Place the measuring tape with tape slider on the upper edge of the belt.
- The measuring tape shall now pass through the gluteal cleft (and not on buttocks) - to the upper edge of the belt on back. This is length TT.
- The patient slides the tape slider to the centre of the crotch.
- Remove the tape from patient's body. The measurement read at the tape slider position is length K3.



Measure circumference cT

- The measuring belt should be at the waist and around the hips in a straight line form




Managing Gravity


- Because of the challenges of genitals being in a gravity dependent position, adding in a vertical support can assist in added 'lift' and support.
- This can be included into the Elvarex garment to support against gravity.
- With the inclusion of multiple levels of Velcro, a patient can vary the amount of vertical lift depending on the time of day or level of refill.
- The standard way to measure the genital strap is to measure from the perineum seam, up to the midpoint of the trunk. The velcro is placed in the middle of the front of the pants - standard is 2 strips however you can have up to 3 pieces.
- Genital strap measure the length and width of the strap and insert into the comments box.

· Only available in Elvarex

 A standard male pouch is 12 cm medial to lateral and anterior to posterior.
 Should a larger pouch be required, please document in the comments section of the order form. Note: 48 cm is the maximum size and can be dependent on the circumference of the panty.









Measure around the scrotum from left side to right side, then measure from the base of the penis anteriorly, to where the scrotum connects to the perineum posteriorly.

Gussets



- Bellavar is the standard gusset for females. Should you require Elvarex fabric gussets, please request in the comments. Note, 3 cm is the standard width gusset.
- Bellavar is the standard gusset for males. Note: Elvarex is not available for male gussets and the standard gusset is 12 cm for males.



You can also have the crotch in a net material

- Only available for the female crotch.
- It does not offer compression.

Stoma

Option 1

Measuring instructions

- 1. Measure from side seam to side seam rather than from the midline.
- 2. Measure the distance from the top waist band down to the stoma opening location.
- 3. Document the diameter of the opening, note the average is approximately 4.5 cm. Be mindful not to make the opening excessive as it will increase in diameter with donning.

Option 2

If documenting the location is complex, the garment can be donned by the patient and the location of the stoma documented with chalk markings on the garment. The garment can then be shipped back to Emmerich, Germany for post production alteration.



Stumps

Plate Finish The preferred option

- Suitable for rounded, tapered stumps.
- Plate is made from Elvarex fabric with a soft internal lining.
- Measure the true A-G and A-F lengths (or lower if below knee amputation).
- It is recommended that 2 cm is accounted for in the overall length as the plate will provide some stretch and length characteristics.
- Take the circumference of F at the narrowest part of the stump where the convergence commences.



Straight Edge Finish

- Suitable for stumps with a more straight edge appearance.
- Note not suitable for more tapered shapes as can result in a 'dog ear' appearance.






For Upper Limb stumps

For upper limb garments, measure the same as a lower limb garment but account for approximately 1.5 cm in stretch and length from the plate.








Lining options

Please see the attached images for possible locations regarding the placement of lining. It is possible to request additional locations and the production team will be able to offer advice if technically feasible (based on material, size and placement).

Note: lining must be at least 1 cm away from seams and the ends of garments for adequate fixation and optimal outcome.



Silicone patches, strips, dots


- Standard: 5 cm and 2.5 cm dotted waistban.
- Patches: Standard are 5cm x 5cm.
- · Strips: available in the following lengths, 10 cm, 12 cm, 15 cm, 20 cm and 25 cm.

Zippers

- JOBST® compression garments should, if possible, be washed daily, or at least every other day.
- · Please use a regular mild detergent.

- Roll up the wet compression garment in a towel after washing and press out excess moisture.
- · Do not wring.
- Do not dry the compression garment on a radiator/heater or in direct sunlight.
- For tumble dryer compatibility please check your compression stocking's product label.

Sometimes there can be a short adjustment period with your new garments, whether they are your first or you have been wearing them for years.


If you feel that the fit is not exactly right, please continue to wear your garment as prescribed for a period of 2 weeks and follow these trouble shooting ideas.

- Garment should be washed every day, or at least every other day, at 40°C.
- If the garment feels too loose, wash in hot water up to 60°C.
- If the garment feels too tight, continue to wash as per the general care instructions.
- After 2 weeks, if the fit still does not feel right, please contact your therapist for review.

Apply a liner. Either the open toe Soft Liner (white) or the closed toe Liner (beige).

With the Soft Liner, ensure you extend the fabric past the toes distally and past the knee proximally to allow sufficient fabric to fold back over the wraps once they have been applied. Unwrap the Foot Piece and lay it on the floor with the hole for the heel closest to you.



Place the foot on top of the Foot Piece, resting the heel over the hole in the Foot Piece.



To secure the foot, hold the Foot Piece flap closest to the toes on each side and pull both sides over the top of the foot to the opposite side. Apply at or near end stretch with the VELCRO®.

Now apply the remaining flap (the one closest to the ankle) in the same manner.



After securing the forefoot, hold one side of the ankle band and pull it over the top of the mid-foot to the opposite side and secure it in place at or near end stretch.



Repeat the same step with the other half of the ankle band on the opposite side.

When removing the Foot Piece, fold the VELCRO® over on itself and back on the same band.

Apply a JOBST® Farrow liner and Foot Piece if applicable.

Unwrap the Leg Piece and lay the wrap on the floor behind your leg with the label side furthest back and facing up. The shortest bands will be closer to the foot.



Grab each side of the band closest to your ankle and pull forward wrapping the band around the lowest part of the leg at or near end stretch and affix with the VELCRO®. Undo the top band before applying the second last band to ensure the final band sits over the top. If wearing a Foot Piece, the bottom band should overlap the Foot Piece.



Place the wrap with its spine positioned behind the leg starting from the ankle and finishing just below the knee.

Apply the top wrap as an anchor to hold the wrap in place. Then commence wrapping from the ankle up towards the knee.



Repeat with each band moving up the leg, smoothing out any wrinkles as you go.

Before applying the bandages, ensure good skin care has taken place.



Measure the Protouch® Stockinette to be used as protection by measuring the length of the total arm from fingers to shoulder tip.



Apply the Protouch® Stockinette to the length of the arm, allowing a small hole for the thumb.



To bandage the fingers, start an anchor at the wrist with a gauze bandage.



Coming from the wrist, make approximately two turns around the finger with light tension before returning over the back of the hand. Ensure you leave the finger tips free.



Secure each finger bandage with an anchor around the back of the hand.



The completed finger bandages should be on the dorsum of the hand, leaving the palm free.



Pad the limb with Artiflex®, starting at the base of the metacarpal heads and leaving a hole for the thumb.



Bandage up the limb with 50% overlapping turns.



Additional padding may be added for extra protection.



Continue applying padding up the limb. It is recommended that a wider size padding is used beyond the forearm.

Start the compression bandaging with an anchor at the wrist (bandage 6 cm width).



The turns run from the back of the hand to the palm, returning to the back of the hand.



After one turn across the middle phalanx of the thumb, hold the edge of the bandage down.



To prevent pocketing between the thumb and index finger, press down the edge of the previous turn.



Repeat this turn once more.



After two turns around the hand, the first Comprilan® bandage should end two figures of eight just behind the wrist.



The patient presses a clenched fist against the therapist's abdomen and tenses their muscles. An 8 cm width bandage is started from the wrist.



Run in long figures of eight or spirals, using 50% overlap, up to the elbow.



Start a new 10 cm width bandage and commencing in the opposite direction, in figures of eight or spirals, wrap up the limb, over the elbow and up to the upper arm.



Secure the end of the bandage with adhesive tape and roll over the Protouch® Stockinette for protection.



Ensure there are no gaps in the bandages to ensure no fluid accumulates in any area not compressed with bandage.

Apply undercast padding from the base of toes to tibial plateau in a spiral configuration. The layers assist in absorbing exudate and to correct any distortions of the natural contours of the leg.



Commence bandaging at the base of the toes, working from inside to outside, with the barrel of the bandage facing upwards.



Keep the tail of the bandage short and apply firmly over the dorsum of the foot maintaining an even tension without overstretching.



Bandage twice around the foot.



Wind bandage over top of foot, cover outside ankle, inside ankle and return back over top of foot and wind under heel.



Instructions as per step 5.



Wrap bandage around inside ankle to outside ankle joint. Ensure heel flap from first bandage is covered.



Continue to wind bandage in a spiral configuration to base of the tibial plateau or two finger width below the knee.



The bandage is applied in a spiral configuration with a 50% stretch and 50% overlap.



Secure bandage with clips or tape e.g. Leukopor® or Leukoplast®. Any excess bandage is placed down the leg without compression.



Lower Limb application technique using JOBST® Compri2 AND JOBST® Compri2 Lite



Apply toe bandaging if toe or significant dorsal foot oedema is present (for lymphoedema patients).



Apply the compression padding with the foot at an angle of 90 degrees. Start by wrapping it around the foot, starting at the base of the toes. Continue wrapping it around the foot, overlapping the padding on the back of the foot so that half of its width covers the ankle.



The next turn of the bandage goes over the heel. If necessary, prominent points on the leg can be additionally padded with cut-offs of the padding.



Continue bandaging as far as the knee and ensure 50% overlapping. The padding should fit the shape of

the limb with minimal stretching.



Remove excess material and press the end of the padding on lightly.



An indicator on the compression bandage helps to ensure correct tension by changing from an oval to a circle when correct tension is applied.



Start by wrapping it around the foot at the base of the toes.



Pass it around the ankle in two or three figure of eight, ensuring the heel is completely covered. Ensure the foot is kept at 90 degrees.



Continue wrapping the compression bandage around the lower leg, overlapping by at least 50%, keeping the bandage under even tension. The indicator on the bandage will be a circle when the correct tension is applied.



Cut off excess bandage material and press the compression bandage on lightly. This will ensure the bandage adheres well to itself and to the padding.



Upper limb application techniques using JOBST® Compri2® Lite



Equipment

Set up with the required equipment (foam is optional to protect bony prominences).

Always include the fingers for an upper limb application. Skin care and wound care first (if applicable).
