RECOGNIZING THE SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF LIPOEDEMA

- Symmetrical increase of fatty tissue in the legs (less often the arms)
- Larger legs compared to narrow waist and slender upper body
- Pain in the affected area and tender to touch skin
- Affected emotional wellbeing, e.g., low self-esteem

LIPOEDEMA

- Only women Associated with phases of weight gain and hormonal changes; puberty, pregnancy, menopause
 Eamily bistory is common in fema
 - Family history is common in female members
 - Symmetric (both limbs), the hands or feet are not affected
 - Pain due to inflammation and hypoxia
 - There is no progress, if obesity does not progress

OBESITY

- Men and women
- Can already develop in early childhood, but it is not limited to a certain age group
- Family history is common
- Affects the whole body, usually symmetrical
- No specific signs, especially no pain in the affected limb
- Likely to progress with risks of e.g. chronic heart diseases, diabetes and joint degeneration

LIPOEDEMA VERSUS LYMPHOEDEMA

LIPOEDEMA

- Only women
- Symmetric (both limbs) lower extremity more often
- Interstitial fluid does not accumulate
- No swelling of foot/hand
- Bacterial cellulitis is uncommon
- Pain due to inflammation and hypoxia
- Caused by hypertrophy and hyperplasia of adipocytes leading to inflammation

LYMPHOEDEMA

- Men and women
- Asymmetric (often only one limb), upper and lower extremity
- Interstitial fluid accumulates
- Swelling of foot/hand possible
- Bacterial cellulitis is common
- Feeling of tension due to interstitial fluid
- Caused by a defect or overload in the lymphatic system
