Do you know how much more waste is generated using two-layer compression bandages instead of JOBST® FarrowWrap® or JOBST UlcerCare? Let us put it into perspective.

The below scenarios are based on **only one patient with one venous leg ulcer (VLU) on one leg**, treated over six-months¹⁻⁹.

Based on three bandage changes per week, up to **72 bandage changes** are needed¹⁻⁹. Double this amount (up to 144 bandage changes) if both legs are bandaged...

The combined height¹⁰ (m) of two-layer compression bandages* used is up to **914.4 METRES**

Two-layer compression bandages are single use only and cannot be recycled. This clinical waste must go to a landfill.

NURSING TIME IMPACT

Compression bandages require specialist training to apply, meaning up to 72 nurse visits would be needed to heal a VLU over a six month period³.

Each visit takes on average 45 minutes¹¹, this would total **up to** 54 hours of nursing time.

By switching to JOBST FarrowWrap or JOBST UlcerCare³:

- Patients can apply and adjust the garments themselves as part of supported self-care
- If the patient cannot apply the garments, carers or family members can apply (specialist nursing training is not needed)

ADDITIONAL COST OF BANDAGES^{12,13}

Compression bandages need to be changed up to three times per week¹⁻¹⁰, meaning a significantly higher cost of overall treatment.





2-in-1 compression system for the **treatment of active venous leg ulcers** (VLU).

- Kit provides 40mmHg of compression at the ankle, as recommended by the National Wound Care Strategy Programme (NWCSP) for the healing of VLUs¹
- Liners provide 15-20mmHg of mild compression, ideal for Immediate and Necessary Care (NWCSP)¹
- · Liners contain silk for ease of donning
- Only two measurements required
- Available in seven sizes as a Ready-to-Wear (RtW) range. Also available as a Custom-Fit (MtM) garment
- Ability to wear normal shoes helping to reduce the risk of falls compared to compression bandages from an improved range of ankle motion (ROAM)¹⁴
- Available with or without a zipper




