Compression therapy is a vital component in the management of chronic swelling from lymphatic and venous conditions.

For certain patients, however, management can be difficult to maintain independently. It is therefore important to offer patients suitable compression solutions that are efficient and easy-to-use, to help improve therapy outcomes and empower patients to confidently care for their own needs.

Give your patients the choice and variety needed to take control of their own care and support them to achieve better therapy outcomes with adjustable wrap compression systems.

In oedema management, adjustable wrap compression systems (or compression wraps) can be used as a first-choice treatment option and offer an alternative to multi-layer bandaging or hosiery.

They have similar short-stretch properties to multi-layer bandaging in that they have low resting pressure and a high working pressure. As a result, they may create peak pressures that stimulate lymph flow. They are designed for easy use which enables patients to independently self-apply and adjust as their swelling reduces.

Which of your patients would benefit from a wrap compression system?



Chronic Oedema

Patients with swelling resulting from lymphoedema and venous oedema:

- · With fluctuations in limb swelling
- In decongestive and / or maintenance phases







Larger body sizes

Patients unable to don or unsuitable for compression garments / bandages through:

- Obesity
- Overweight or larger body sizes
- Irregular shape of limbs
- Skin folds

Venous leg ulcer

Patients with open wounds between the knee and the ankle:

- Enables patient to change dressings as required
- Allows patient to remove to carry out personal hygiene routines

Physical limitations

Patients unable to apply or remove compression hosiery / bandaging due to:


- Arthritis or weak hand strength
- · Back problems
- Sensitive or fragile skin at risk of breakdown
- Relying on carer-support

They are designed to provide the same strong support as multi-layer bandaging but in a simplified, intuitive design.



Overlapping bands replicate the principles of multi-layer bandaging.

Compression self-care tips for your patients



Washing the wrap

To prevent sticking, patients should be advised to fold the VELCRO® brand hook and loop fastener back on itself before washing. A special wash bag should further protect the wrap.



Pay attention to wounds

Before applying JOBST FarrowWrap, patients should ensure any wounds are thoroughly cleaned. They will also need to cover any open wounds that are present in the area being treated with a suitable wound dressing before applying compression.



Skin care

Application of professionally recommended moisturising creams will help your patients avoid infections and achieve the best possible treatment outcome.



The right shoes

Safe footwear is important to reduce the risk of patient falls and to help protect JOBST FarrowWrap from any unnecessary wear and tear.



Diet

Because obesity may worsen pre-existing lymphoedema, following a healthy and balanced diet is generally recommended.



Storage

To ensure a longer garment life-span, JOBST FarrowWrap should be properly stored. Instruct your patients to fold the VELCRO® brand hook and loop tabs back on themselves to avoid sticking.
